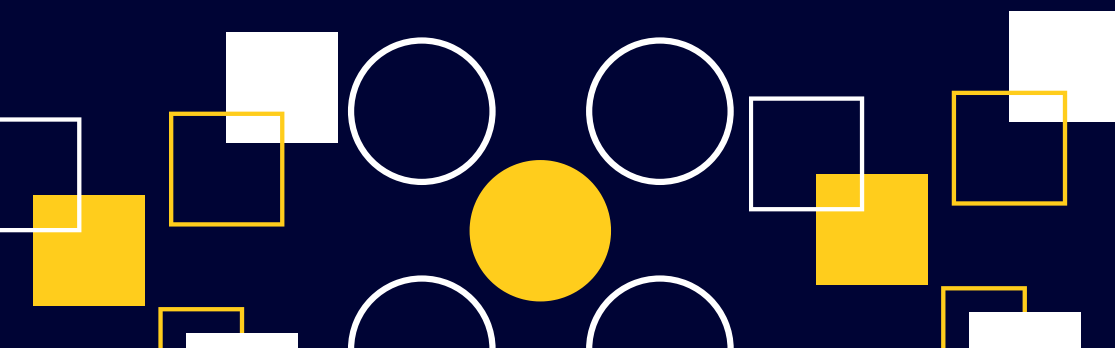

All core subjects are offered along with Bible and ministry classes, chapel, electives, special needs enrichment, and trade classes.

A Christian worldview, God's design, discipleship and a ministry focus will be emphasized in each class and subject.

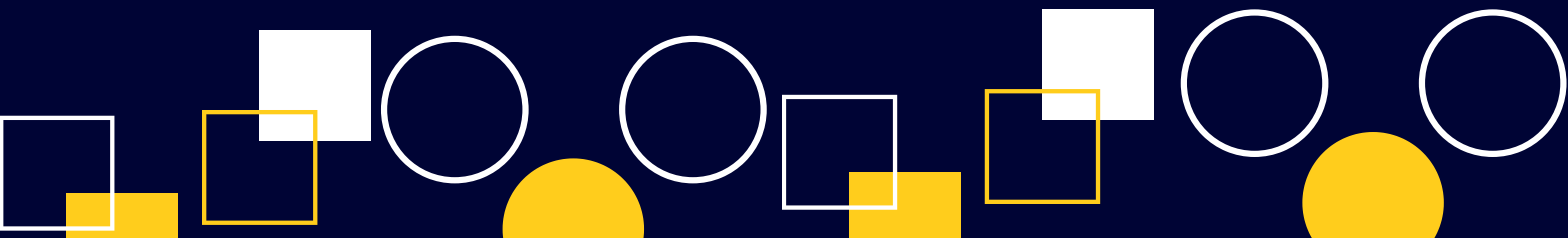
Students at the high school level have the choice of block scheduling and the pursuit of dual enrollment cohort college classes through a Christian University.

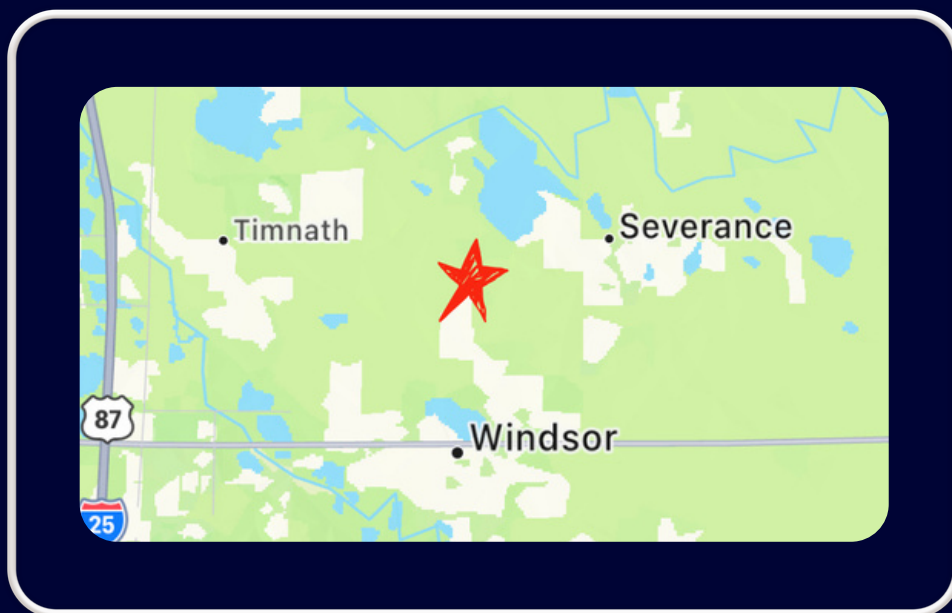




FUTURE LOCATION

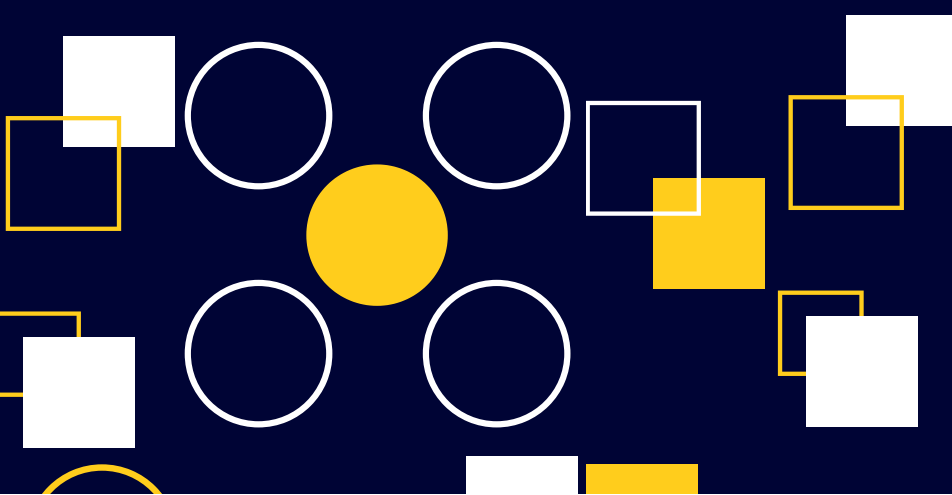

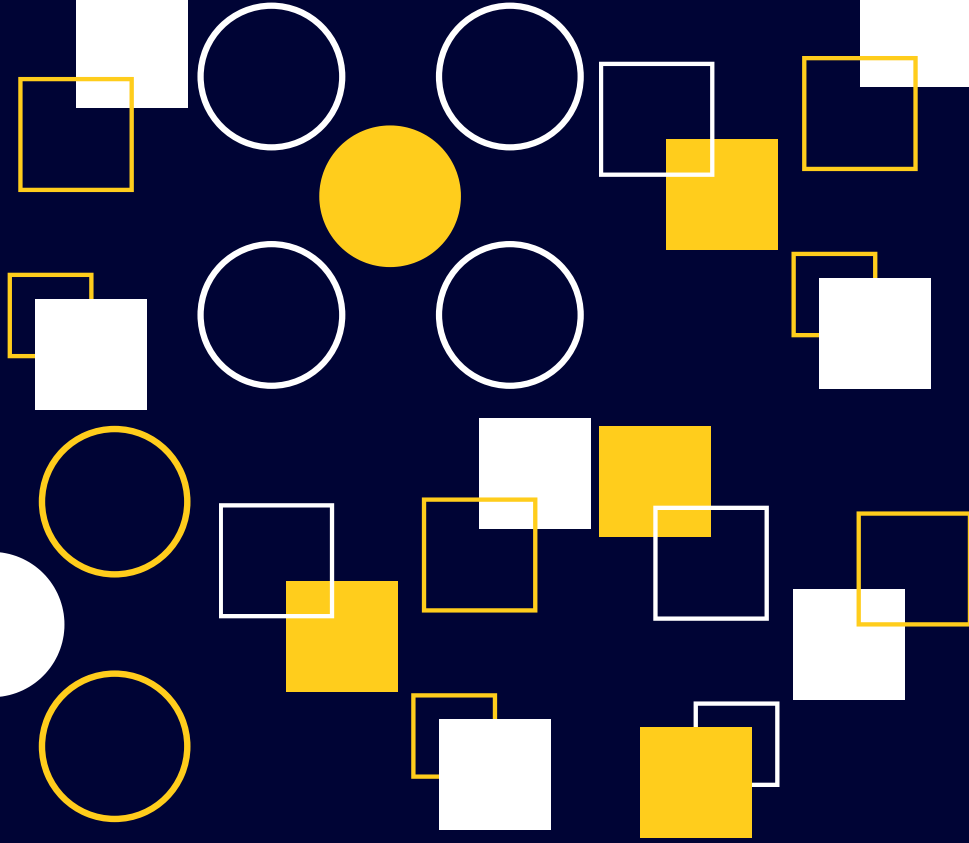
